### A LEADER IN INNOVATION FOR CHILDREN, YOUTH, AND YOUNG ADULTS WITH DISABILITIES

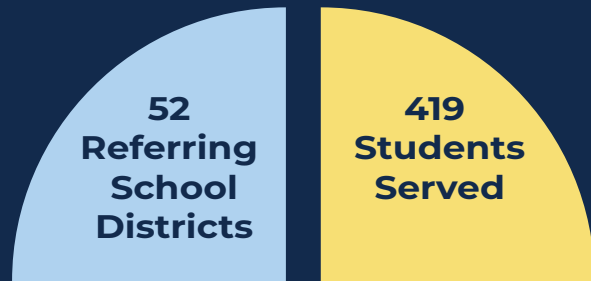

**Residential Program** - Full time care in a family setting to small groups of children and youth

**Behavior Management Services** - Family Support Services program which each participant had a complete behavioral assessment and support plan developed specifically for them

**Enhanced Home and Community Based Waiver Services Program;**  
Providing a combination of in-home staff support and out of home therapeutic respite stays paired with our Behavior Management Services to assist families who have a need for additional support

**Medical Respite Program** - Provides day and overnight respite for children and young adults with complex medical needs
